Dr. M. S. Chauhan, Director, Karnal gave suggestions as under:

- Proper experimental design in the research projects of Dairy faculty.
- In experimental design specify the breed of animals.
- Conduct small trial initially and take it to experimental scale.
- Thorough discussion of the research projects at college level.
- Invite subject matter specialist to evaluate the prepared projects.

Dr. P. H. Vataliya, Director of Extension Education, KU suggested as follows:

- Complete the cycle of research.
- Identify the core focus area in all faculties.
- In all research projects recommendation, be made.
- Through scrutiny of research results should done before it comes in final reports/public notice.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, KU gave concluding remarks as under:

- Publish the recommendations in the form of booklet for wider circulation of the stakeholders.
- Scientists are advised to choose uniform methodology for Research Programme.
- Recommendations shall be made from the research work conducted.
- It is mandatory for Principal Investigator (PI) of the project to present the report.
- PI to submit quarterly report in time. The Dean of respective faculty will thoroughly screen the report and submit to Director of Research.
- In New Technical Programme, the responsibilities of Co-investigators are fixed and accordingly contribution shall be specified in percentage and there shall not be more than 3 Co-PIs.
- Prior to project proposal, screen it thoroughly and appropriately review the work done. This will strengthen the project before it is presented in the VASRC.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor felicitated Dr. P. H. Vataliya for his contribution in the veterinary field for more than three decades. He offered Shawl & Shrifal to Dr. P. H. Vataliya.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks by Dr. R. G. Shah, Associate Director of Research. He expressed gratitude to Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, KU for his valuable inputs in the meeting. He also thanked Dr. P. H. Vataliya, Director of Extension Education, KU for his contribution in establishment and development of Directorate of Extension Education, KU and valuable suggestions in the VASRC meeting.
